INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

1. Use a **BLACK** pen.
2. **TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL () TO THE LEFT OF YOUR CHOICE COMPLETELY.** An oval () blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.
3. If you wish to vote **straight party** blacken the oval () to the left of your party choice.
4. To cast a **write-in vote** for a person whose name is not on the ballot, **blacken the oval to the left of the line** provided and print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.
5. If you make a mistake **DO NOT ERASE.** Ask for a new ballot.
6. **REMOVE STUB** before casting ballot.

STRAIGHT PARTY

You may vote a Straight Party Ballot for the party of your choice by darkening the oval to the left of the party of your choice
OR
You may split your ballot by darkening the oval to the left of the party of your choice and voting for individual candidates in any other party.




AMENDING THE MANDATORY JUDICIAL RETIREMENT AGE
