At this Get Help Now PA! Help Desk, volunteer professionals will meet with you and discuss ways for you to address your financial difficulties. While they will not be able to serve as your lawyer or credit counselor in these meetings or thereafter, these volunteer professionals will be able to help you to identify and contact organizations that can address your specific concerns.
